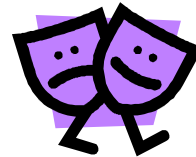

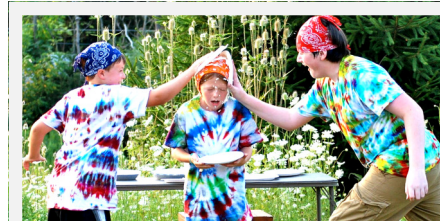

## Enrichment Classes



### Week 1 Enrichments: Heroic Hollywood
